30 hours Eligibility

All Parents who qualify for 30 hours (for child/ren who turned 3 before 31 August 2021) must confirm on the Childcare choices website

www.childcarechoices.gov.uk by the 31st July to get your 11 digit eligibility code (starts with 5000 or 11) for next term September 2021. You must give us your eligibility code for verification with the local authority and sign a Parental Declaration and agreement not later than 6th of August 2021. For others who are already on the scheme, you will need to re-confirm your eligibility every 3 months and give us the eligibility code again for verification. You can also contact HMRC on 0300 123 4097 if you have any problems with getting a code.

You can use the Childcare choices website to also apply for Tax - free Childcare if you don't pay fees with Childcare vouchers.

If this is your first time of applying for 30 hours, you have to inform us in writing before 31stof July (info@gracenursery.co.uk) that you want to increase your hours as we may not have any vacancies or speak to the Manager if you have any other questions.

Updates for September 2021

An updated risk assessment in line with Government guidance will be sent to you before Nursery starts in September. Dates for the Autumn term are in this newsletter and for the academic year on the website. We were assessed last week for the Quality Mark Award, the report should get back to us next week and will feedback to you in the Autumn newsletter.

<u>Training</u>: The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) has been updated and applies from September 2021. Staff will spend the training days in September looking at the new framework, Safeguarding and language/literacy outcomes for children. Food

A reminder that you will have to provide a packed Lunch or pay monthly in advance if your child(ren) is 3 and over except for full time payers. Lunch money must be paid into the Bank account as we no longer take cash in the office. You will receive our food policy on packed lunches as soon as your Child is 3 by email which needs to be read together with the risk assessment. A paid lunch can be changed by giving 4 weeks notice. For further information please speak to someone in the office. I have attached a leaflet about eating food safely and preventing children from choking.

Sessions and updating personal details

Your agreed sessions or hours cannot be changed every week. Sessions can be changed if there is a space and must be done in writing 4 weeks before the required change.
